Steve Maguire (CPT, U.S. Army Ret.), member of the U.S. Army Ranger Hall of Fame, and recipient of two Purple Hearts, commits his support for the Declaration of Allegiance on National Purple Heart Day 2020.

On August 7th each year, the nation observes National Purple Heart Day as Americans honor and remember the men and women wounded in battle and the fallen heroes that have paid the ultimate sacrifice with their lives.

As an Airborne-Ranger, infantry officer commanding a 9th Infantry Division battalion reconnaissance platoon in Vietnam; Maguire was critically wounded and blinded for life.

The Declaration of Allegiance is an initiative of the U.S. Allegiance Institute, allowing signatories to sign and unite as one allied force for supporting full compliance and enforcement of Article II, Section I, Clause 5 of the U.S. Constitution.
